Security Corner

Safety Tips to Protect Kids from ID Theft

Did you know that children are prime targets for identity theft?

That's because their identities can be exploited for years before anyone notices. It's not until they apply for their first loan that the problem is discovered. Here's what you can do to help protect them.



Safeguard their private information as

if it were your own. Before providing social security numbers for routine forms for school, sports or the doctor's office – ask if it's really necessary. Why do they need it? How will they protect it? In some cases, they may accept just the last 4 digits; or better yet - not use it at all.

Teach kids not to share personal information online or by text. Details like phone numbers, addresses, birth dates and passwords can give an ID thief an unwanted advantage.

Check annualcreditreport.com for your child's credit report each year. There shouldn't be one until after they've applied for their first loan.

Once your son or daughter has a legitimate credit report, teach them how to keep tabs on it by visiting annualcreditreport.com and checking the details for accuracy. Each of the three credit bureaus allows one free credit report per year. Consider staggering them – check one every four months to keep a close watch. Make sure you're checking yours, too!

The following nomination procedure is an official notice. In August of 2016, the Northland Area Federal Credit Union Board of Directors appointed a Nominating Committee. Nominations for Board positions will be accepted until 11/10/16. The Nominating Committee will then meet and file its report, which will be published in the January edition of Northland News.
